November 10, 2020

Regular meeting of the Grant Township Board called to order by Supervisor Dysinger. Board members present: Dysinger, Teall, Shea, Bell, Zinser. 7 guests present. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Agenda. Motion to approve agenda with changes by Marge Bell, supported by Dick Zinser. Yeas; all present.

Minutes. Motion to approve October 13, 2020 minutes by Dick Zinser, supported by Tammy Shea. Yeas; all present.

Treasurer report. Motion to approve Treasurer report by Supervisor Dan Dysinger, supported by Tammy Teall. Yeas; all present. Tammy Shea reported that the tax billing for winter taxes is going smoothly and there will be an increase in property taxes due to the passing of Transit, MSU Extension, Animal Shelter, and Gypsy Moth Millages.

Assessor. Supervisor Dan Dysinger gave a report on work done on Herring Joint Drain assessment at large was under \$400.

Road Commission report. Supervisor Dan Dysinger presented the board with a Preliminary Road Plan for 2021 through 2023 estimated cost to the township will be one million dollars over the three-year period. Tammy Shea inquired about the Sheridan participation on Cornwell, Supervisor Dan Dysinger will inquire with Sheridan Township about the Cornwell road projects. The project was agreed upon for 2019 but CCRC removed it from the project list. Marge Bell asked about ditching, Supervisor Dan Dysinger said Kapplinger Ave and Locust Rd are on the proposed list.
