MARCH 9, 2021

Regular meeting of the Grant Township Board called to order by Supervisor Dysinger. Board members present: Dysinger, Teall, Shea, Bell, Kunse. 5 guests present. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

- a. Tom Kunse informed the board about the online Board of Review class he attended put on by MTA. The class was very basic training, it covered FOIA, public forum and the inflation multiplier which is 1.4%. Supervisor Dan Dysinger agreed and said the BOR takes the advance class.
- b. Supervisor Dan Dysinger reported that the Board of Review wrapped up today, there was a small turn out, lowest ever, but everything went smooth. In April or May, the Grant Township Assessor will be attending a board meeting to inform the board what they need to know about Assessing Reform.

**Road Commission report.** Supervisor Dan Dysinger reported that the staking of Kapplinger has begun, also the replacement bridge on Surrey Road is set to begin in May. The road for thru traffic would be closed for 2 to 4 weeks depending on variable conditions.

**County Commissioner.** The board discussed the cost of the Gypsy Moth Spray Program to the township residents.
