

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT FIRE PROTECTION MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

RESOLUTION **2026-10** GRANT TOWNSHIP, CLARE COUNTY, MICHIGAN

At a meeting of the Grant Township Board, Clare County, Michigan, held at the Grant Township Hall on the 5th day of May, 2026, at 6 p.m.

PRESENT: Lake, Gilmore, Gregory, Teall

ABSENT: Isaac

The following was moved by Tammy Teall and seconded by Linda Gilmore.

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Grant Township wishes to renew the millage for fire protection services that expires after 2026; and

WHEREAS, Grant Township may provide fire services, as authorized by MCL 41.801, et seq, and other applicable statutes; and

WHEREAS, Grant Township may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Township Board wishes to renew the millage for fire protection that expires after 2026, which millage was originally authorized at 1.0938 mills. The previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Grant Township, Clare County, of 1.0938 mills (\$1.0938 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 1.0824 mills (\$1.0824 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be **renewed** at 1.0824 mills (1.0824 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for **ten (10)** additional years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Grant Township, Clare County, Michigan, approves the following millage renewal question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 2026 election ballot:

GRANT TOWNSHIP FIRE PROTECTION MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Grant Township, Clare County, of 1.0938 mills (\$1.0938 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 1.0824 mills (\$1.0824 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be **renewed** at 1.0824 mills (1.0824 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for **ten (10)** additional years, **2026 through 2035 inclusive**, for the purpose of contracting for fire protection services and any other purpose authorized by law to provide fire protection service to the Township, raising an estimated **149,927 in 2026?**

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF GRANT TOWNSHIP

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that at the election to be held in Grant Township, Clare County, Michigan, on Tuesday, August 4, 2026, the following question shall be submitted to the qualified electors:

GRANT TOWNSHIP FIRE MILLAGE RENEWAL
1.0824 MILLS FOR 10 YEARS

4. The question to be voted on at said election shall be stated in substantially the same form and manner appearing on the foregoing Notice.

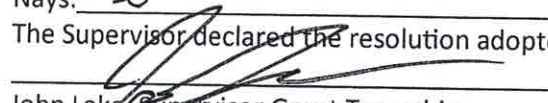
5. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby rescinded.

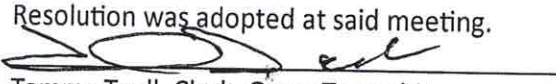
