RESOLUTION TO ADOPT ROAD IMPROVEMENT RENEWAL MILLAGE
QUESTION

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-09

At a meeting of the Grant Township Board, Clare County, Michigan, held at the Grant Township Hall on the 5th day of May, 2026, at 6 p.m.

PRESENT: Lake, Gilmore, Gregory, Teall

ABSENT: Isaac

The following was moved by Brendan Gregory and seconded by John Lake.

WHEREAS, Grant Township may impose and levy *ad valorem* property taxes to finance lawful public services as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws, and may provide funds for road improvements as authorized by MCL 247.651, et seq; and

WHEREAS, the roads within Grant Township are in need of improvement; Grant Township previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Grant Township, Clare County, of 1.2 mills (1.2 per \$1,000 of taxable value) reduced to 1.1802 mills (\$1.1802 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be **renewed** at 1.1802 mills (1.1802 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and be levied for ten (10) additional years, beginning in **2026 and through 2035 inclusive**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Township Board approves the following millage renewal question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the November 3, 2026, election ballot:

GRANT TOWNSHIP ROAD IMPROVEMENT MILLAGE

Shall Grant Township previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Grant Township, Clare County, of 1.2 mills (1.2 per \$1,000 of taxable value) reduced to 1.1802 mills (\$1.1802 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be **renewed** at 1.1802 mills (1.1802 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and be levied for ten (10) additional years, beginning in **2026 and through 2035 inclusive**. for the purpose of the improvement of public roads within Grant Township, raising an estimated \$168,260 in 2026?

2. The Township Clerk is directed to post and publish notices of registration and notices of election, have ballots prepared and provided in sufficient quantity, and do all things and provide all supplies necessary for the submission of this question at the election according to law.

GRANT TOWNSHIP ROAD IMPROVEMENT MILLAGE RENEWAL 1.1802 MILLS FOR 10 YEARS

QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTORS

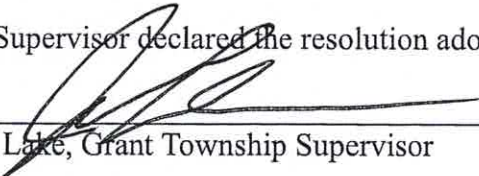
4. The question to be voted on at said election shall be stated in substantially the same form and manner appearing on the foregoing Notice.

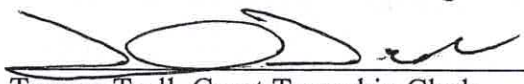
